1. All non-MOD pass holders must provide two forms of identification, one with a photo. Non UK Nationals will be required to provide passport ID and be accompanied by a UK National.
2. Non car-pass holders will need to enter via Crash gate 1 (Back Gate) - Black Bourton Road. RAF Brize Norton car pass holders must enter via crash Gate 2 (Main Gate) and park at their place of work. With the exception of disabled badge holders, who will park opposite the Station Gym, no other vehicles will be allowed onto camp.
3. All Persons entering the Station could be liable to search.
4. Pets prohibited except guide dogs. No barbecues.
